CFNI - New Needs Fund - closing date for applications - 28 Aug 2020  
Funding for Community-led Initiatives Addressing New Challenges Resulting from Coronavirus Crisis in Northern Ireland A new £600,000 Fund has been launched to support the voluntary and community sector in Northern Ireland in dealing with the effects of the coronavirus crisis in the medium term. Constituted organisations with charitable purposes and grassroots organisations working within their local community can apply for funding, provided they have an income of £1 million or below. Grants of between £3,000 and £15,000 will be awarded to community-led responses. Applications will be assessed on a rolling basis. Organisations should apply as soon as possible since the demand for the funding is expected to be 'significant'.
